## PROPOSED ASSIGNMENTS:

PROJECT 1: DEVELOPMENT OF WATERWAYS MONITORING AND DATA MANAGEMENT CENTRE (WMDMC).

PROJECT 2: UPGRADE OF LAGOS STATE WATERWAYS AUTHORITY SEARCH AND RESCUE TEAM (LASWA-SAR).

PROJECT 3: ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENHANCED AIDS TO NAVIGATION SYSTEM ON LAGOS WATERWAYS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF NAVIGATIONAL EFFICIENCY AND SAFETY.

## 1.0. BACKGROUND:

- 1.1. Lagos State Government (LASG)'s mission and vision to reduce congestion on our roads, promote an effective and safe water transport system is a done-deal. Lagos, with population of over 20 million people and projected to be the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest smart city in the world within the decade hitting the 25 million population mark, is Nigeria's economic, financial, and commercial nerve-Centre.
- 1.2. Like any other regulatory body, Lagos State Waterways Authority (LASWA) is confronted with the task of effectively coordinating all daily monitoring and enforcement activities, which is always daunting without the right tools. Therefore, to pass accurate information, decisions and planning, there is need to deploy technology assisted solutions.
- 1.3. It is imperative here to note and consider the value of an efficient emergency and rescue support plan for the State Inland Waterways to have a quick response module of operation to combat high rate of casualties and fatalities from the incessant boats accidents on our waterways.

1.4. LASWA's essential function include clearing and maintaining State Inland Waterways free from all obstructions, derelicts, gauges, distance boards and markings along the Inland Waterways. Hence, the Authority shall undertake installation and maintenance of all navigational aids along water channels and banks of the waterways.

## 2.0 INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTERESTS

- 2.1 Within the context of the State's extant Procurement Laws, LASWA invites Expression of Interests from registered and qualified Consultants that are interested in the projects mentioned above.

## 3.0 SELECTION METHOD

- 3.1 Selection process shall be conducted through Quality and Cost Based Selection method (QCBS). Shortlisted Consultants shall submit Technical and Financial Proposal to determine the most responsive Consultants.

- f. Corporate Profile with Curriculum Vitae showing evidence of professional qualifications of key personnel, years of experience and staff strength.
- g. Verified evidence of two (2) similar assignments successfully completed in the last five years (e.g Letter of award and Certificate of Completion)
- h. Evidence of registration as Consultant with Lagos State Public Procurement Agency in appropriate class
- i. Any additional information that may enhance your bid.

#### **5.0 Sworn Affidavit disclosing as follows:**

- That all documents submitted are not only correct but genuine
- That the Director(s)/ Partners have never been convicted by any court of Law
- That none of the firm's Director(s)/ Partners or any company is bankrupt
- Whether or not any of the Firm Staff is a member of Lagos State Government in the past or presently.
